



Beyond Green

Banning single-use plastics and providing refillable water bottles are great starting points for a sustainability-minded brand. But at Beyond Green, there's a list of more than 50 sustainable criteria each property must hit to become a part of their portfolio. With a growing collection of properties everywhere from Laguna Beach to Mongolia, Beyond Green counts resorts like Dominica's Coulibri Ridge, which not only has replaced in-room trash bins with compost boxes, but also uses copper-ionization for its swimming pools. (The latter tech limits the need for harsh chemicals and uses low-voltage electrical current to keep fresh water free of algae and bacteria.) At andBeyond Sossusvlei Desert Lodge in Namibia, the lodge's water system recycles more than 26,417 gallons of gray water a month. Then, in French Polynesia, the ultra-luxury Brando resort has the goal of creating a zero carbon footprint. "Not only is the property remarkably sustainable," says Marchant, "it is in a league of its own and one of the most romantic and elegant private island settings the world over."
